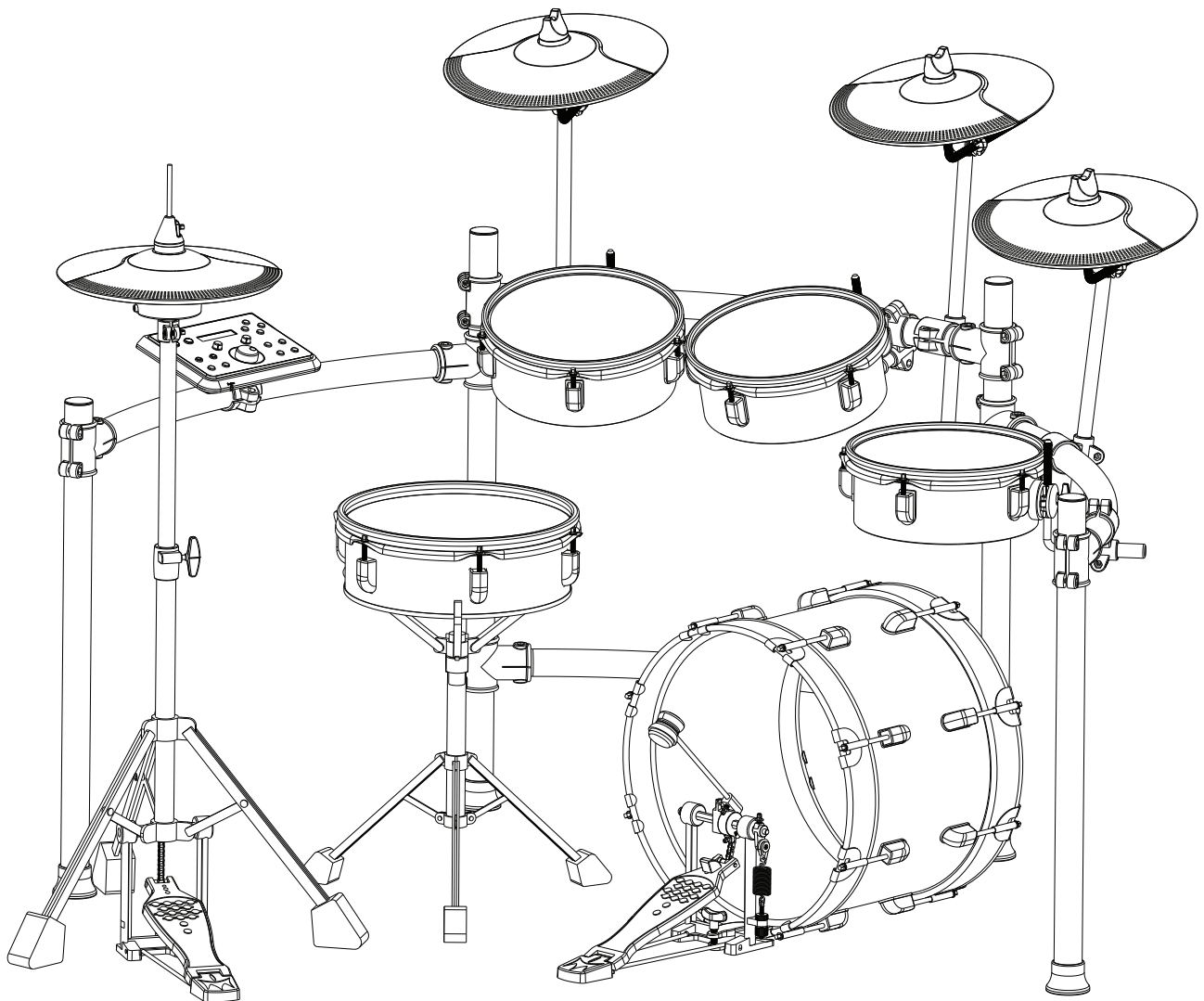

INFORMATION FOR YOUR SAFETY!

Power Supply

Please connect the designated AC adaptor to an AC outlet of the correct voltage.

Do not connect it to an AC outlet with voltage that is different to what your equipment is made for.

Unplug the AC power adaptor when not using the instrument, or during electrical storms.

Connections

Before connecting the instrument to other devices, turn off the power to all units. This will help prevent malfunction and / or damage to other devices.

Location

Do not expose the instrument to the following conditions to avoid deformation, discoloration, or more serious damage:

- Direct sunlight
- Extreme temperature or humidity
- Excessive dusty or dirty location
- Strong vibrations or shocks
- Close to magnetic fields

Interference with other electrical devices

Radios and televisions placed nearby may experience reception interference. Operate this unit at a suitable distance from radios and televisions.

Cleaning

- Clean only with a soft, dry cloth
- Do not use paint thinners, solvents, cleaning fluids, or chemical impregnated wiping cloths

Handling

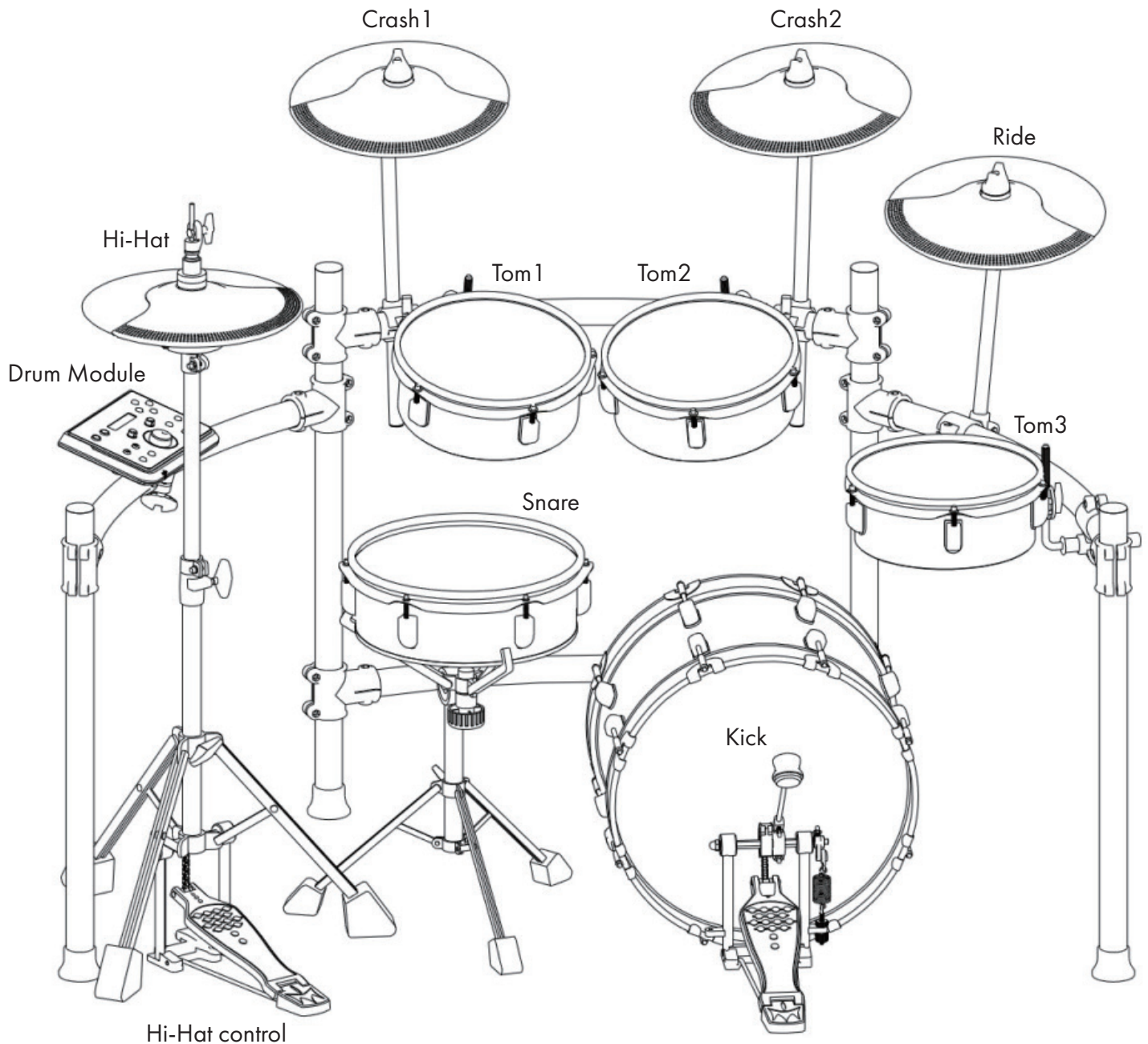
- Do not apply excessive force to the switches or controls
- Do not let Paper, metal, or any other object hit the Drumkit or the Power Adaptor
- If this happens, unplug the AC adaptor from the wall outlet
- Then have the instrument inspected by qualified service personnel

Disconnect all cables before moving the instrument.

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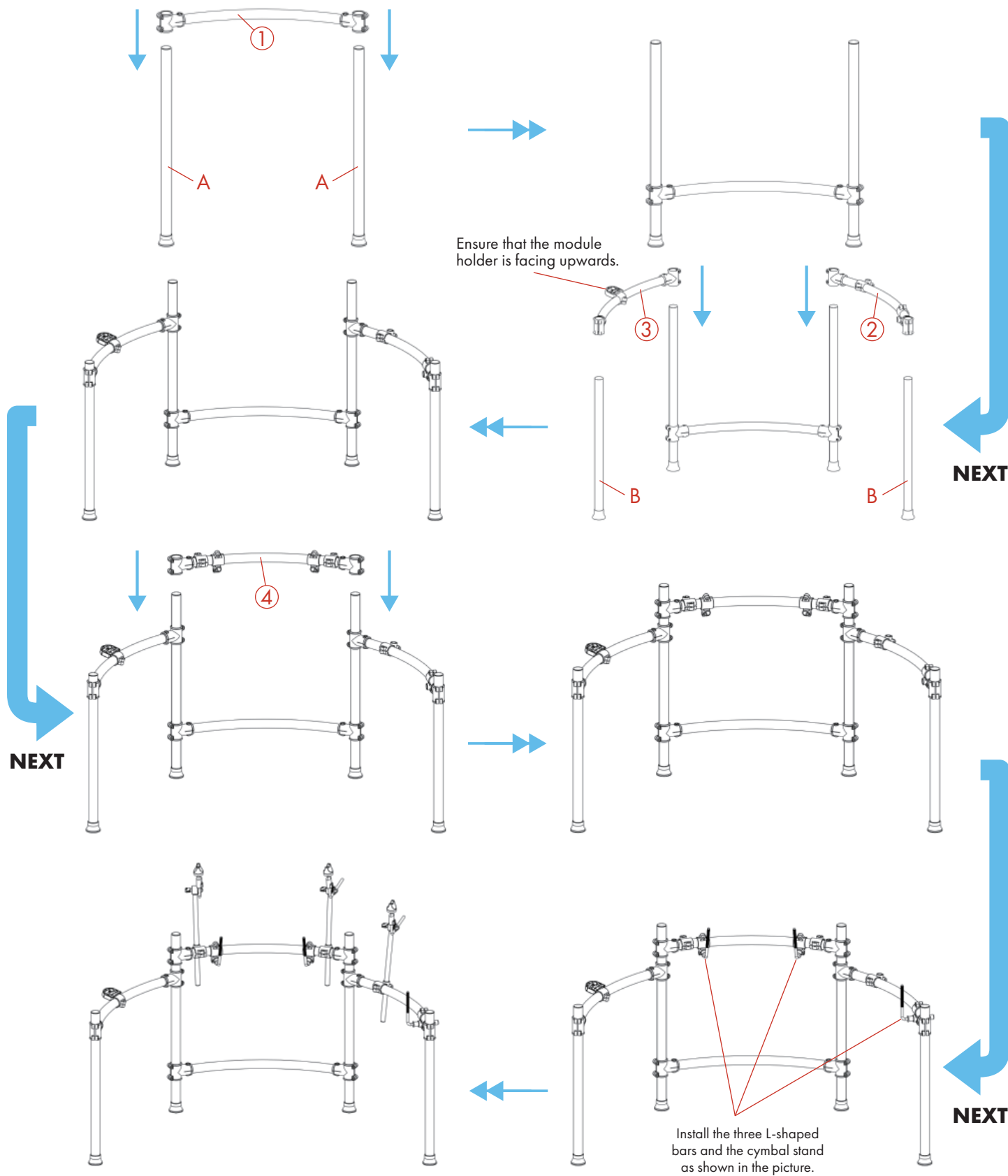
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INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



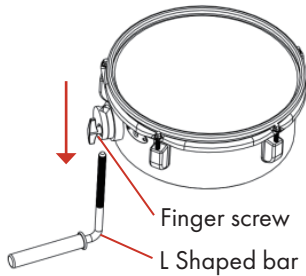
1. Frame Installation:

Please follow these steps to install the frame:



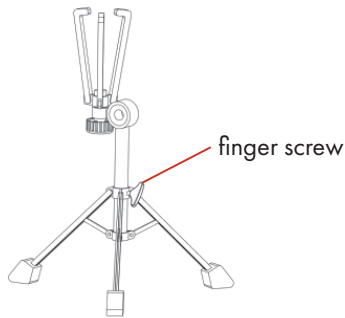
2. Installing TOM Pads:

Install the TOM pad onto the L-shaped bar on the frame. Adjust the height and angle, then tighten the finger screw on the TOM pad.

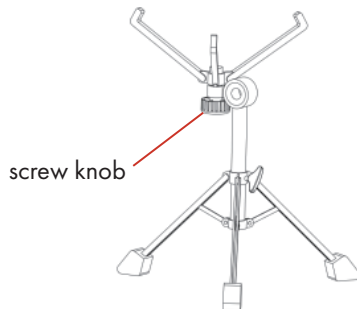


3. Installing the Snare Drum:

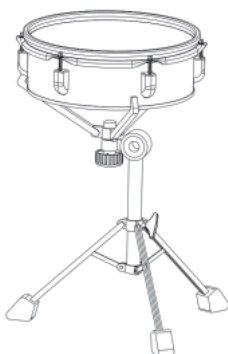
1. Insert the claw part into the bottom of the stand, adjust the height, and tighten the finger screw on the stand.



2. Loosen the screw underneath the claw to open it.

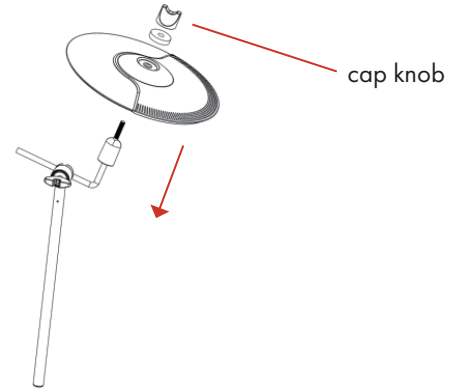


3. Place the snare drum on the snare stand, then tighten the claw.



4. Installing Cymbals:

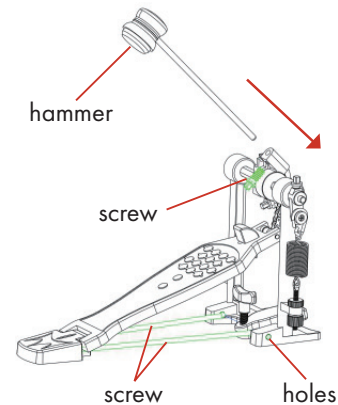
1. Follow the diagram to install the cymbals on the cymbal stand.



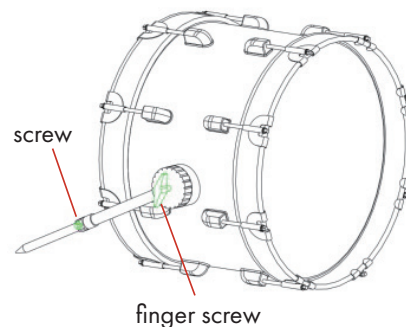
2. Adjust the angle of the cymbals as needed.

5. Installing the Kick Drum:

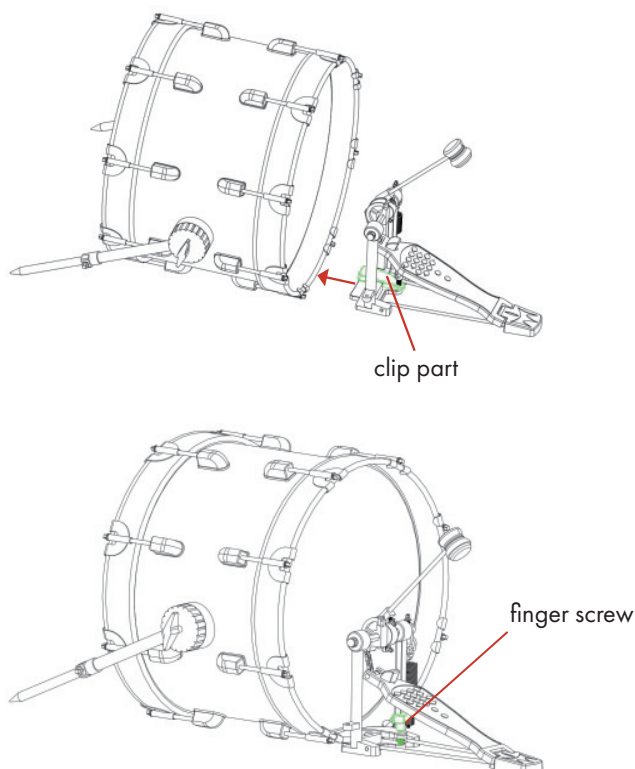
1. Attach the hammer to the kick pedal, adjust the height, and tighten the screw.



2. Install the standing bar into the holes on the kick pedal.
3. Adjust the direction of the kick drum legs by loosening the finger screw.
4. Loosen the screw to adjust the length of the kick drum legs, ensuring the kick drum is stable on the floor. Then tighten the screw and finger screw.



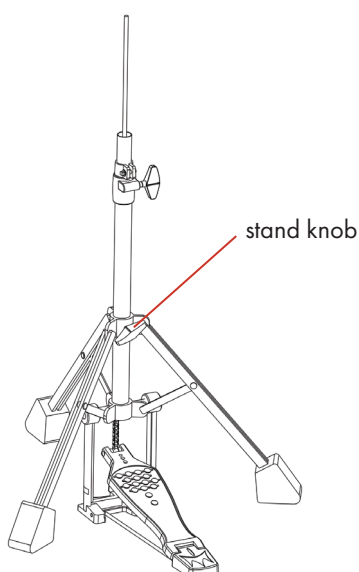
5. Attach the kick pedal to the kick drum, clipping it to the bottom front part.



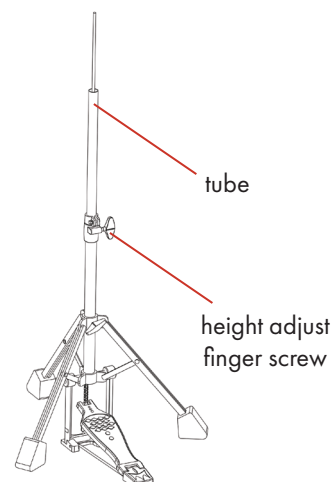
Note: Ensure the trigger position is at the top front of the snare drum.

6. Installing the Hi-Hat Pad and Pedal:

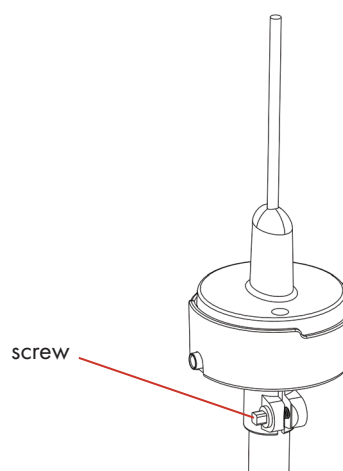
1. Loosen the stand screw, open the support foot, adjust it, and retighten the screw.



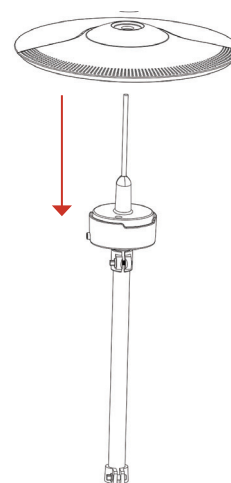
2. Loosen the height adjustment screw, lift the tube to be at a comfortable height, then retighten the screw.



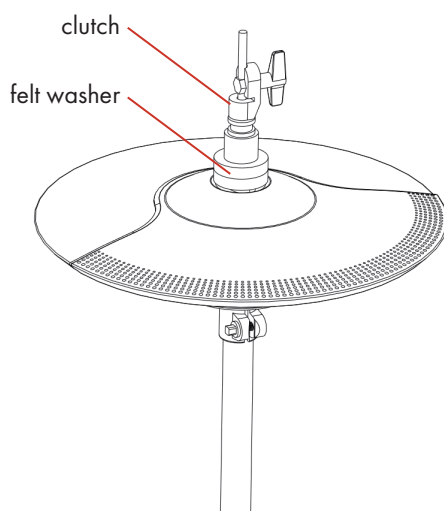
3. Place the Hi-Hat trigger on the tube.



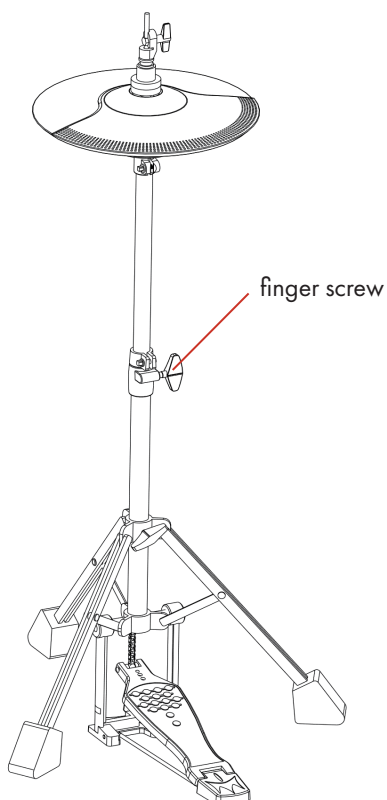
4. Install the Hi-Hat cymbal on top of the Hi-Hat trigger.



5. Be sure to install the felt washer and clutch without pressing down on the cymbal.
6. Tighten the finger screw on the Hi-Hat pedal.

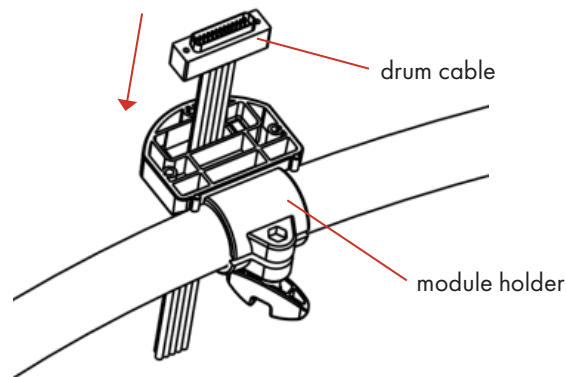


7. Adjust the height of the Hi-Hat stand as needed.

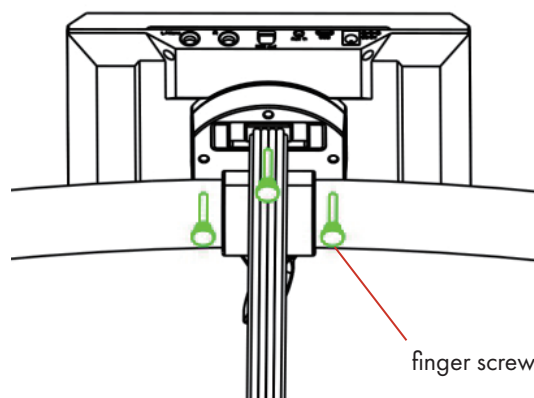


7. Installing the Module

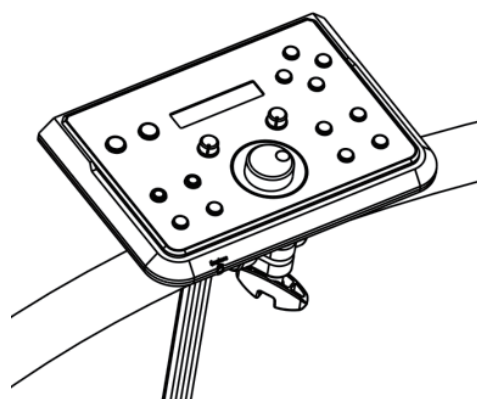
1. Insert the drum cable through the module holder.



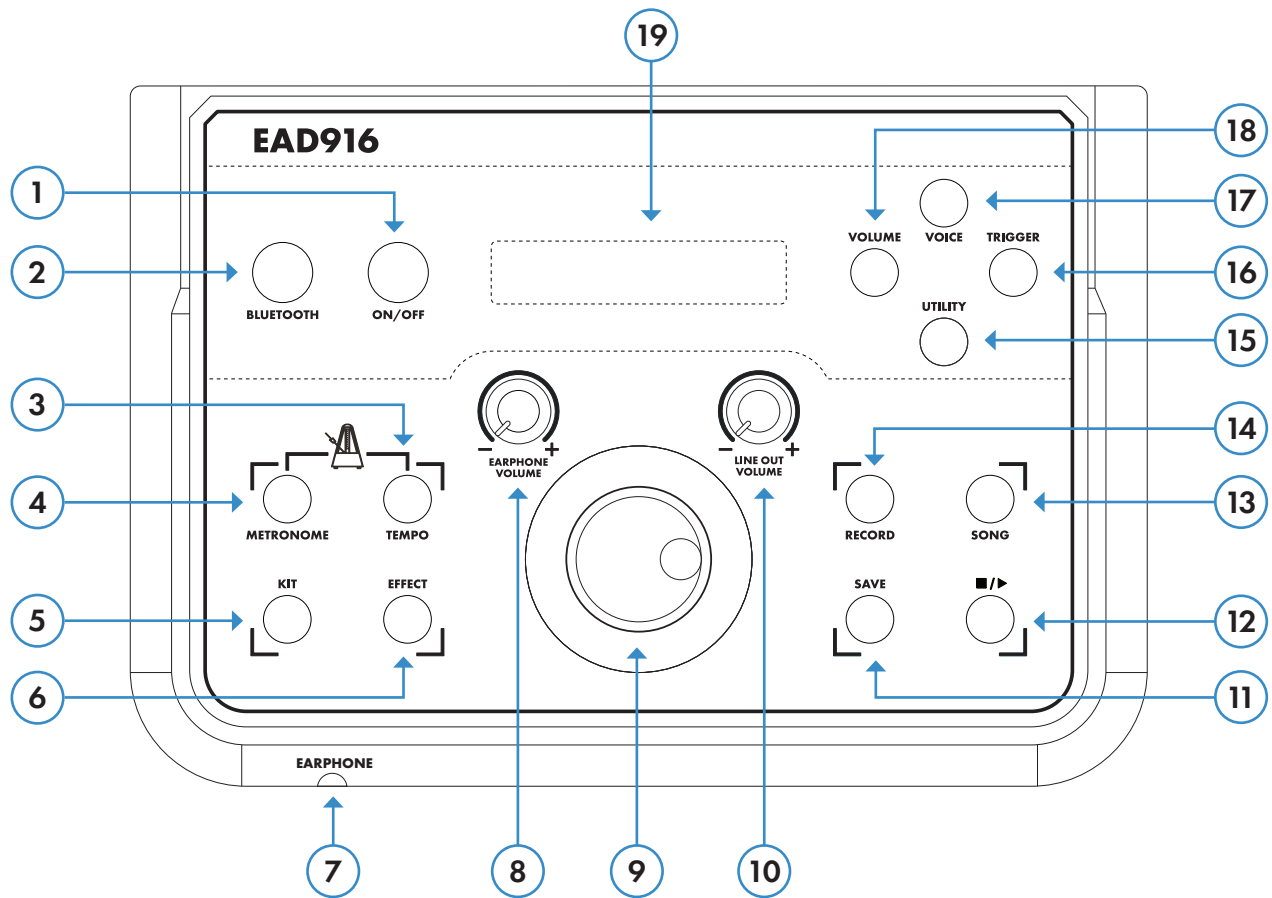
2. Connect the drum cable to the module and place the module onto the holder. Tighten it using the three finger screws.



3. Adjust the module's angle by adjusting the module holder's direction.

SETTINGS

Kit Selection

The EAD916 comes with 13 preset kits and 8 user kits. To select the desired kit, press the **KIT** button, then use the encoder wheel to select a preset or user kit.

Metronome

Press the **METRO** button to start the metronome. The LED will flash, and you will hear beeps immediately.

You can adjust the time signature, volume, and tempo using the encoder wheel.

To adjust the time signature, press **METRO**, turn the encoder wheel until you see it flashing next to **METER**. Press the encoder wheel. You can now turn the wheel left or right to add or remove beats from the time signature.

To adjust the metronome volume, press **METRO**, turn the encoder wheel until you see it flashing next to **VOLUME**. Press the encoder wheel. Turn the wheel left or right to reach your desired volume.

To adjust the tempo, press **TEMPO**. Turn the wheel left or right to reach your desired tempo.

Reverb

The EAD916 comes with five different reverb sounds. To adjust the reverb, press the **EFFECTS** button and use the encoder wheel to choose settings for **TYPE**, **LEVEL**, **TIME**, **SIZE**, **H GAIN**, and **L GAIN**.

Once you have found the setting you want to adjust, press the encoder wheel to adjust the value of that setting.

Demo Songs

This drum kit comes with 30 demo songs to help you practice and learn drumming. To begin playing with a track, press the **SONG** button to access the demo song menu. Use the encoder wheel to select a song, then press the **START/STOP** button to play or stop it.

You can also deactivate or adjust the volume of the drums in the demo song so that you only hear your own playing. To do so, press **SONG**, turn the encoder wheel until you get to **DRUM**, then press the encoder wheel and turn it to turn the backing drums on and off.

RECORDING

1. Press the **RECORD** button to start recording. The LCD will display "ON". When you are finished, press again to stop recording ("OFF").
2. To play back the recorded song, press the **START/STOP** button.

Note: The recorded file will be overwritten with any new recordings.

CREATING USER KITS

1. Press the **VOICE** button and hit the pad or cymbal you want to adjust. The LCD will show the name of the selected pad or cymbal.
2. Use the encoder wheel to adjust the volume, reverb, pan, MIDI key, or other settings. Press the encoder wheel to confirm each setting.
3. After finishing adjustments, press **SAVE** to save the user kit to one of the available user kit slots. The EAD916 comes with 600 samples, so feel free to customise the user kits however you like!

PAD VOLUME SETTINGS

1. To adjust the volume of each pad, please **VOLUME** and hit the pad or cymbal you want to adjust. The screen will display the name of the pad.
2. Use the encoder wheel to adjust the volume, reverb, pan, MIDI key, or other settings. Press the encoder wheel to confirm the setting, then turn left or right to adjust the value.
3. After finishing adjustments, press **SAVE** to save the user kit to one of the available user kit slots.

TRIGGER SETTINGS

1. Press the **TRIGGER** button, then hit the pad or cymbal you want to adjust. The LCD will display its name.
2. Use the encoder wheel to adjust settings like **Threshold**, **Velocity Curve**, **Sensitivity**, **Mask Time**, and **Crosstalk**.
3. Press the encoder wheel to confirm the setting, then turn left or right to adjust the value.

MIDI CHANNEL SETTINGS:

1. Press the **UTILITY** button, then use the encoder wheel to select the **MIDI CH** option.
2. Adjust the MIDI channel, then press the encoder wheel to confirm.
3. This is useful for syncing the EAD916 to your DAW and ensuring that the pads on the drum kit match the samples of your virtual drum program.

HI-HAT AND SNARE DRUM TYPE

1. If you want to swap what sort of hi-hat or snare you are using, then you will need to adjust these settings.
2. For a hi-hat, you can use either a pedal (001) or a stand (002). The unit will default to a hi-hat stand. For a snare, you can use either a 12" snare (001), an 8-10" snare (002), or a 14" snare (003). The unit will default to a 12" snare.
3. Press the **UTILITY** button to select either **HIHAT TYPE** or **SNARE TYPE**.
4. Use the encoder wheel to choose the correct type, then press the encoder wheel to confirm.

FACTORY RESET

1. Press the **UTILITY** button and select **DRUM RESET** from the menu.
2. Turn the encoder wheel to select **ON**, then press the encoder wheel again to reset the device.

BLUETOOTH SETTINGS

1. Press the **BLUETOOTH** button to toggle Bluetooth on or off.
2. When enabled, the Bluetooth name will appear as "**EDRUM**". If you have trouble reconnecting, remove the device from the Bluetooth list on your phone and re-pair it.
